

KCDP Recognized Caucus

1. Definition of Caucus

- a) For the sake of this rule the definition of Caucus is a group of KCDP members who have come together to advocate for a certain issue or set of issues (i.e. Labor-Educator Caucus, Progressive Caucus, and Pride Caucus).

2. Recognition/Sanctioning

- a) Once a Caucus has a minimum of four members and has formed a steering committee, they may petition the KCDP for recognition.
- b) The request for recognition shall be placed on the agenda at the next monthly meeting for approval by the membership, by a majority vote.
